In addition to the movie, several food trucks will offer gourmet treats including tamales, cheese steaks, seafood, lobster rolls, barbeque pulled pork, crepes, burgers and more.

The Friends of Ocoee History Preservation will give the tours of the Withers-Maguire House. Built in 1888, the house is of a Gothic Stick style with Florida heart pine wood floors throughout the interior of the home which is encompassed by a wrap-around porch.
