## LAKE PRIMA VISTA WATER QUALITY TREATMENT NOTIFICATION

Due to a materials shipping delay, the City will begin conducting the lake treatment project on Lake Prima Vista in mid-July. The project was previously scheduled to begin the week of June 28th. The lake treatment project will address persistent algal blooms and improve water quality conditions. The treatment project will use both liquid aluminum sulfate (alum) and powder-based Phoslock® products that are designed to clear the water and inactivate phosphorus within the targeted lake sediments.

Project staging will occur at the Sleepy Harbor boat ramp. During the alum application, lakefront residents will likely notice snow-like “floc” particles forming under the water as the alum works to bind with suspended algae and settle out. In addition, aquatic organisms may become stressed during the alum application process as a result of a temporary decrease in water pH. Phoslock® will be applied immediately following alum treatment and water will be cloudy for approximately 48 hours. The Consultant and City staff will observe the application process to manage any adverse conditions, and the City appreciates your support and patience through this project.
